Registration Instructions

- The classes will be separated into either Law Enforcement or Auxiliary categories. Law Enforcement means you are a professional law enforcement officer (you are paid) who has arrest powers. Auxiliary means you are a Non-Law Enforcement patrol or posse member who volunteers for a law enforcement agency and do not have arrest powers.
- This year's competition will introduce 10 awards for best overall combined scores of Equitation and Obstacle. Obviously you must compete in both events to be eligible and to attain a numeric score in each event.
- There will also be awards for the top 10 in the Equitation Class, the top 3 in the Western Class and the top 10 in the Obstacle Course individually.
- The Equitation Class will be an individual test performed in a 20 X 60 meter dressage arena. A diagram will be provided on the NAPEC website at the time the Equitation pattern is posted.
- Register your intent to compete in the Team Obstacle and register your team as well. However, you can make changes at any time up to 2 hours prior to the start of the Obstacle Course. Mixed teams are welcomed and encouraged (i.e. members from different departments). Teams consist of 3 members.
- You may make changes up to 2 hours prior to the start of each event i.e. classes horses, riders etc. Pre-registration is necessary to prepare the program and lineup for the obstacle and equitation classes.
- Registration is \$100 per rider, which includes the banquet on Sept. 29. Guests will be charged \$35.
